## TACKLING INVASIVE PLANTS

Himalayan balsam and monkeyflower are invasive non-native plant species that grow prolifically on our river banks, outcompeting native species and dying back over winter, leaving the banks susceptible to erosion.

To remove these species from the riverbanks we hand pull them from the roots - it's easy, fun and anyone can join in!
