1. Minutes of the meeting 16<sup>th</sup> July 2014 were agreed unanimously and signed by MG.
2. **Matters arising –**
  - 2.1 Local bus service – RL & TF/BM will encourage users in both villages to complete the questionnaire included in the proposed new timetables.
  - 2.2 Parish Steward –promised works still outstanding and next steward visits unclear. **PO & MG** will pursue with Wiltshire Highways
3. **Planning –**
  - 3.1 Tree replanting – BM to clarify PC's position with Bev Griffin (cc Mike Wilmott) re ensuring replacement of removed trees.
  - 3.2 15 Wilsford - Applicants are experiencing inconsistent and lengthy decisions from WC, PO supporting and will pursue, a PC councillor will attend and present support at planning board meeting once modified plans have been submitted.

  - 4.4 Clerk agreed to limit work to 1 hour/week to keep within minimum wage constraint.

6. **Pewsey Area Board/PCAP/WC reports** – RL attended October PAB (minutes & notes already circulated) TF attended November meeting (minutes due) PCAP minutes circulated .PO warned of continued cost cutting and devolution of funding through PAB.

  - 7.1 Community Resilience Planning – comments received, **CB** will include in next version .Next draft to be presented to appropriate bodies for comment/approval.
  - 7.2 Wilsford phone kiosk JD presented argument to remove kiosk, all agreed.
  - 7.3 Defibrillator – purchase discussion non-conclusive, decision at next meeting.
  - 7.4 GSW = signs have appeared along public RoWs despite non support from WC and landowners where no signs are allowed. **PO** continues to resist all current plans for GSW. Richard Broadhead offered to give presentation to PAB re WC position.
  - 7.5 Gritting equipment – TF has purchased and is in process of making it available to PCs on request. Payment of services TBD.
  - 7.6 CsP streetlight. **DH** to report to responsible company.
  - 7.7 CsP T-junction. DH presented briefing note from Richard Giles re damage to verges and walls by extra large vehicles.TF declared interest as most traffic due to his property development. **DH** to ask Highways for advice.
  - 7.8 CPRE – previous meeting agreed PC will not join as member.
  - 7.9 Flooding – MG has stored gel-sacks and jackets at Wilsford Manor.

### **Further information:**

#### **Policing operations –**

A two night drugs operation was conducted in late July, in partnership with Tidworth NPT to disrupt, stop search and deal with offences in relation to the illegal use of controlled drugs. This event also provided intelligence gathering and resulted in the issue of a cannabis street warning to one individual. More recently a further operation was conducted in the Pewsey area and a warrant executed in Tidworth resulting in three persons arrested on suspicion of cultivation of cannabis.

A rural crime operation was conducted on the evening of 17<sup>th</sup> August, working in partnership with the Rural Crime Team and Marlborough NPT, covering the Pewsey villages, in response to an increase in reports of night-time poaching activity and criminal damage to farmland.
